



The 'tree huggers' are designed to protect your trees, from the rubbing of the wire, but more importantly to prevent ringbarking the tree.






Each tree hugger kit contains:

Tensioning the zip line with a winch


The start end of the Fox in a Box kit is secured to the start anchor by:

1: Pulling the wire to required tension.

This is a simple process but the wire rope weighs 380 grams per meter, so Step 1 can get heavy on longer zip lines.

2: Wrapping the wire around the anchor.







For Zip Lines less than 20 meters: You probably wont need a winch, but just incase a simplified winch is included.

For Zip Lines up to 35 Meters: The simplified winch will be adequate.

For Zip Lines between 35 and 120 Meters: The heavy winch will be perfect.







It will work well for installing kits upto 120 meters
